## What is: Willo'Wind Farm Vegetable CSA?

Willo'Wind Farm is a 50-acre family farm based in Zephyr, Ontario, since 1983. Our garden is cultivated using organic practices and our farm is home to many farm animals and other wildlife.

**Community Supported Agriculture (CSA)** is a system of growing and distributing organic produce that restores the connection between farmers and community supporters. CSA systems provide farmers with an equitable return for their labor and establishes a strong foundation for sustainable agriculture while contributing to a healthier environment

By **purchasing a CSA** you are guaranteed a weekly portion of fresh vegetables that are harvested straight from our gardens throughout the summer months. Your commitment also supports sustainable farming, preserves biodiversity, and builds a healthier, local and sustainable food system

#### 1. Type of CSA

We offer a regular and large CSA share. A Regular Share would be suited to 1-2 adults or a small family.

A Large Share would be suited to 2 adults who eat a lot of vegetables or a larger family.

#### 2. Pickup and Delivery Options

With your CSA: the option of picking it up at the **Farm** and **Uxbridge Farmers Market**, **Junction Farmer's Market** or have your box delivered to your door.

The Brickworks CSA is pickup only.

We deliver to Uxbridge and surrounding hamlets, Zephyr, Sandford, Leaskdale.

We deliver to Toronto in the area between Lawrence Ave W to the Gardiner Expressway and

Keele St to the Don Valley Parkway.

There is a delivery fee for the delivery option to cover the costs of gas and time to deliver.

We also offer a discounted delivery fee for group delivery.

## 3. <u>Eggs!</u>

Willo'Wind also offers eggs from hens raised on our farm in a humane ecological way.
You are able to purchase eggs through our
Egg CSA alongside your Vegetable CSA for a weekly delivery, or simply receive just our
Egg CSA on a bi weekly delivery.
Check how many dozen requested in section 3 on application form.
For people only wanting the Egg CSA & no
Vegetable CSA, only fill out section 3 and section 6-8 on application form.

## 4. CSA Bin Use Charge

This is a charge on top of the Vegetable CSA, to pay for the use of the blue bins that your vegetables come in. This helps share the cost of replacing missing and worn-out bins, as well as the labor involved in cleaning them.

## 5. Food Bank CSA Program!

A program in partnership with our local Uxbridge Food Bank.

We offer a discounted CSA@ \$350 regular share with no delivery fee. The food bank then selects a family they feel might benefit best from the CSA program. Your donation dollars go to help pay for the discounted CSA Share @\$350 delivered, for the family receiving the share. Any donation amount is welcome. We will also fund a CSA share for a family even if all the \$350 to fully pay for the share has not been collected yet.

## 6. <u>Payment Options</u>

You have the option of paying for your CSA in either a one time payment, two payments - (half the cost when you sign up, the other half Aug  $1^{st}$ ). Or five payments (total cost of csa dived by five, with first payment due on sign up and remaining payments made on Jul  $1^{st}$ , Aug  $1^{st}$ , Sept  $1^{st}$ , Oct  $1^{st}$ ) We accept cheques, cash and e-transfers as forms of payment.
